- CONCILIATION- to assist disputing parties with their negotiations
- MEDIATION- to facilitate discussion and assist disputants to reach their own resolution
- MEDIATION-ARBITRATION- (MED-ARB)- to attempt mediation, but failing that, to render a decision on unresolved issues
- ARBITRATION-to hear both sides and issue a binding award
- MEETING FACILITATION-to facilitate group problem solving or planning meetings
